They brought her to see us right away. She was diagnosed with nutritional secondary hyperparathyroidism (AKA Metabolic Bone Disease) and jaw fractures on both sides of her mandible.

Because her jaw needs to be immobile to heal properly, we placed a feeding tube to allow her owners to feed and medicate her without her moving her jaw. She is a brave girl, and we look forward to watching her heal and recover over the coming weeks.
